In indicator of social performance, including (in cooperation with the police in maintaining security, promotion of culture through the establishment of the library and its equipment, rural people participation in decision-making, enhancing rural literacy by organizing literacy classes, courses and extension courses) with mannwhitney value obtained respectively (7523/1, 8974/1, 00/1095, 3013/1, 4883/1) and a significance level of less than 05/0 (05 / 0sig <) is a significant difference between social performance villages large and small villages in the area are 095/0. The environmental performance indicators (including general clean up in the village, collection and disposal of household Zbalh¬Hay in the village, Jzyan prevent sewage in the streets) with the value obtained mannwhitney respectively (8603/1, 4163/1, 4863 / 1) and a significance level of less than 05/0 (05 / 0sig <) is a significant difference between the environmental performance of large villages and small villages there at 095/0.

Conclusion

This has led to efforts to improve the status of this institution more. In the present study aims to investigate the comparison of large and small villages have been adopted successfully in operation Council.
