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Precedency of Crisis in Rural Settlements Using AHP Method: A Case Study of Rural District of Bazoft

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Abstract

Recognition and determination of crisis degree is a subject which is now considered as an important step for the process of planning and is a key to attain the quantitative goals of rural developments for natural structure of environment and socioeconomic and cultural trait of a district. In this study, after introducing the village of Bazoft - the study area- including some natural, economic, social and cultural features, an attempt is made to present a model under caption of analysis hierarchy process (AHP) with the intention of crisis precedency at rural settlements. Eventually by using this method and after determining the intensity and infirmity of crisis in different natural, economic and social dimensions, and categorizing the rural settlements into three groups - stable, sub-stabile and instable - some suggestions are made with regard to reducing crisis and increasing the stability of each district settlement.

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

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
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
