



The Effect of Balint Group on Job satisfaction among Nurses in AL-Zahra Hospital, Isfahan, Iran

Background: Nurses leaving work, is currently one of major problems of the healthcare systems in many countries. The aim of this study was to evaluate of the effectiveness of Balint group on job satisfaction of nurses working in AL- Zahra hospital, Isfahan, Iran.

Materials and Methods: Forty five nurses volunteered and then divided in intervention and control groups randomly but due to high rate of drop-sets, eventually data were analyzed by only 17 cases in each group. Intervention group participated in λ sessions of Balint group in a period of τ months. Job Descriptive Index was completed as pre and posttest. Data were analyzed by MANCOVA- ANCOVA- Levene's statistic - Pearson Correlation-Covariance-T Student Test using SPSS-1 λ .

Results: Balint group was effective only on the subscale of satisfaction from supervisors $(p<\cdot,\cdot\Delta)$.
