

Investigating the effect of surgery care movie in the newborns' congenital cleft lip and palate abnormality on the mothers' caregiving performance

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Abstract

Background: Cleft lip and palate is the abnormality created as the result of abnormal evolution of primary lip and mouth structure in embryo stage. In Iran the prevalence of congenital abnormality of clef lip and palate has been reported from \cdot , \wedge to $^{\prime}$, $^{\prime}$ per $^{\prime}$, $^{\prime}$ live births in various areas. Our study aiming to examine the effect of surgery care movie about the newborns' congenital cleft lip and palate abnormality on the mothers' caregiving performance. **Method:** this study is clinical trial. The sampling method was done according to simple sequential convenient sampling in two experimental and control groups. For experimental group has been shown the surgery care movie, and other group has been give hospital rotini care plan (face to face teaching). Data was analyzed by SPSS $^{\prime}$ software (paired sample T test and independent sample T test) were used. **Result:** The number of the children with abnormality was one in more than $^{9.7}$ ($^{\prime}$ ($^{\circ}$) of the samples and near $^{\circ}$ $^{\prime}$ ($^{\circ}$) of the mothers in both groups their first child suffered from abnormality. The mean score of the mothers' caregiving performance was significantly different after the intervention in the experimental and control groups ($^{\circ}$).

Conclusion: the results show that surgical care movie will be an effective and applicable method in improving the mothers and families' performance in caring the breastfeeding infants with specific needs. In addition to the mother due to giving the movie to the family the other caregivers can use it too.
